





Lesson 1

What's Your Perspective on Bullying?



My name is **KENNEDY!**

I'm here today to talk to you about these folks called SUPERHEROES—and how YOU can become a SUPERHERO, too!



But first, I need to talk to you about something some kids might find a little SCARY. It's this thing called BULLYING.

First, let's get YOUR PERSPECTIVE on bullying. Could you give me an example of something someone might do that looks like bullying?

Lesson 2

What is Bullying?



Great work! Now, my job is to explain what bullying means so we all know how to identify it. Bullying is made up of 4 things:

- Bullying is being MEAN or SCARING someone.
- The behavior must happen OVER and OVER again.
- The target must **FEEL 3 SMALLER** or **WEAKER**on the inside.

And bullying always happens ON PURPOSE!

Why might someone feel SMALLER or WEAKER on the inside? For some people, maybe they're **NEW** to the school. For others, maybe their HAIR is different, or their SKIN is different, or maybe they DON'T even LIVE WITH THEIR PARENTS!

Not everyone feels smaller or weaker from these things, but some do. That doesn't mean they **ACTUALLY** are—it's just how they feel on the inside.

ANYTHING can make you feel smaller or weaker on the inside. What are some things that you might be picked on for? For what reason?

Lesson 3

Meet a Superhero

AMAZING!

Now that we know what bullying is, and we've thought of some reasons why someone might feel **SMALLER** or **WEAKER**, I wanted to introduce you to one of my real life **SUPERHEROES!**



Now, Nevaeh looks really **DIFFERENT**. She has a **BLUE MANE!**



Today, Nevaeh and I want to talk to you about a couple of things.

First, we want to talk to you about **BEING DIFFERENT**, and second, we want to teach you what **SUPERHEROES** do for other people!

Lesson 4

Being Different

So, it's true: Nevaeh looks


DIFFERENT than other horses.

But wait a minute... we ALL

LOOK DIFFERENT from each other! (Unless you're a twin, of course!)

We all THINK DIFFERENTLY, and we all want to do DIFFERENT THINGS when we grow up!

What does that mean? It means we are ALL DIFFERENT!



Being different is AWESOME! It's what makes us UNIQUE and SPECIAL.



But one reason kids might bully others or even exclude them is because they think some kids are **WEIRD** for being different.

Now, we know that doesn't make any sense, because we're **ALL DIFFERENT!** So, we need to find ways to include and accept **EVERYONE**, no matter how different they are.

Lesson 5

Heroes Help

Nevaeh is a **SUPERHERO** of mine because she doesn't care how different I am. She **ACCEPTS** me for who I am.

But Nevaeh also does something **ALL SUPERHEROES** do for other people. She **HELPS** me.


Nevaeh is a **SHOW HORSE**, which means she goes to competitions with me that require a lot of training and practice.



HELPS make me a better person. YOU can help others who are different, too!

Lesson 6

Superhero School



That's why I came here today, to show you how to become a **SUPERHERO!**

l actually went to SUPERHERO SCHOOL!



At Superhero School, they taught me how to JUMP INTO ACTION when I see someone being bullied or mistreated. They told me I only have 10 SECONDS!

When you see someone not being treated the right way, you only have **10 SECONDS** to act before the situation escalates or it's over.

They called it 'OWNING the MOMENT!'



They also gave me the STARTER PACK of SUPERPOWERS! And they're as easy as:

But remember that you're **NOT** a superhero just because of superpowers. Even the bad guys have superpowers!

What makes someone a superhero is their **WILLINGNESS** to do things that other people aren't willing to do, like **HELPING** people who are seen as **WEIRD** for being **DIFFERENT**.

Lesson 7

The Starter Pack of Superpowers

Let's start with 'A!'

It's the first thing every superhero does when someone is in trouble. They fly in and take the person **AWAY!**


You don't even need to talk to the bully; you could just go up to the person being mistreated and say, "Hey, can you help me find the principal?" and take them



Let's move on to 'B!'

This might be the **HARDEST** superpower of them all... becoming someone's **BUDDY!**

Some people might not think this is a superpower, but it is! If one of your buddies was sad or upset or had their feelings hurt, would you know what to do to make them feel better? Of course, because they're your **BUDDY!**



EVERYONE their BUDDY!

Finally, our last superpower is 'C!'

Every superhero MUST CONFRONT the situation, and they do it by using THEIR own unique SUPERPOWER.

Every superhero has a special power (even if they don't know how to use it yet, like that kid who is 'Distracting'). Your power is often what makes you **DIFFERENT** or **UNIQUE**.

Becoming a Superhero


Can you think of more superpowers for the other letters of the Alphabet?

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But sometimes, not every superpower works on every bad guy. Sometimes, you have to CALL ANOTHER SUPERHERO for HELP!

Remember, there are always other **SUPERHEROES** around to help you!



GREAT JOB, but before we go, let's review: Bullying is being MEAN or SCARY, it happens **OVER** and **OVER** to someone who is seen as different (SMALLER or WEAKER), and it's done ON PURPOSE. But remember: We are ALL DIFFERENT.

We also gave you some superpowers, so, if someone is being picked on or even being bullied, you can **HELP** them.

You only have 10 SECONDS to JUMP INTO ACTION and take someone...

AWAY!

But if you don't make it in time, you can still become their...

BUDDY!

And remember, you might have to use **YOUR** superpower to...

CONFRONT

the situation or CALL for help!
