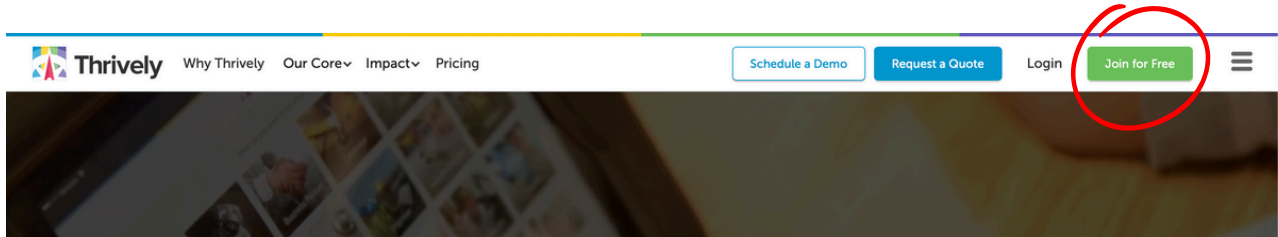

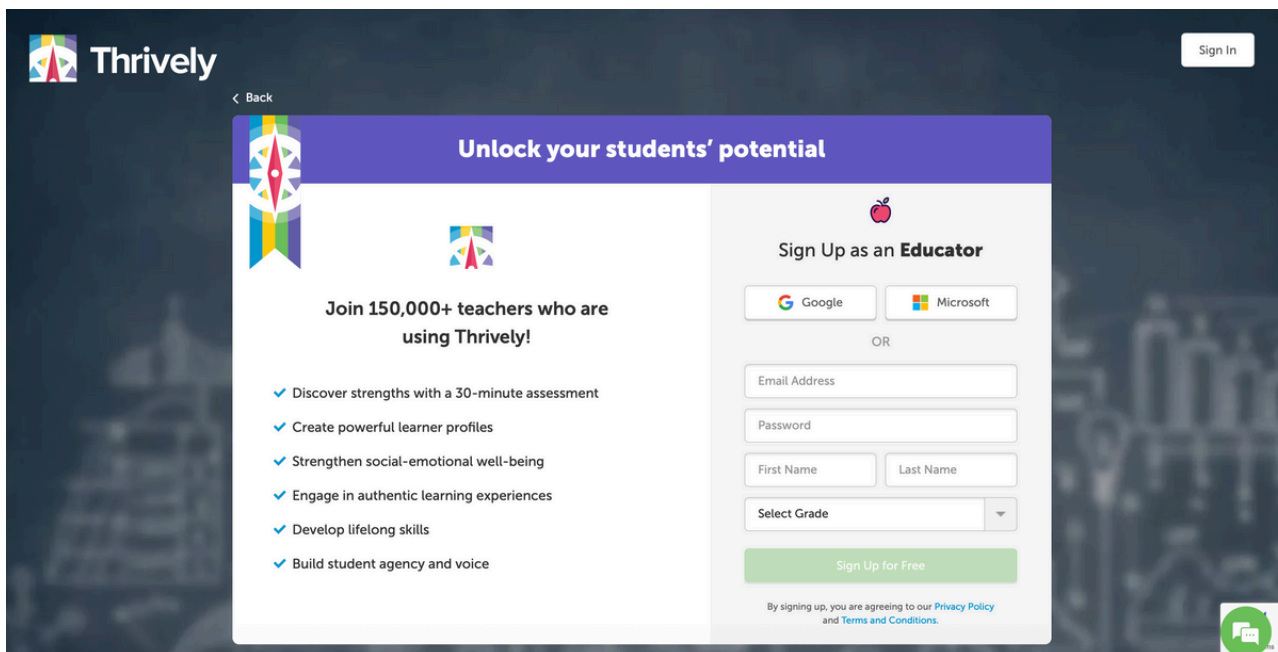

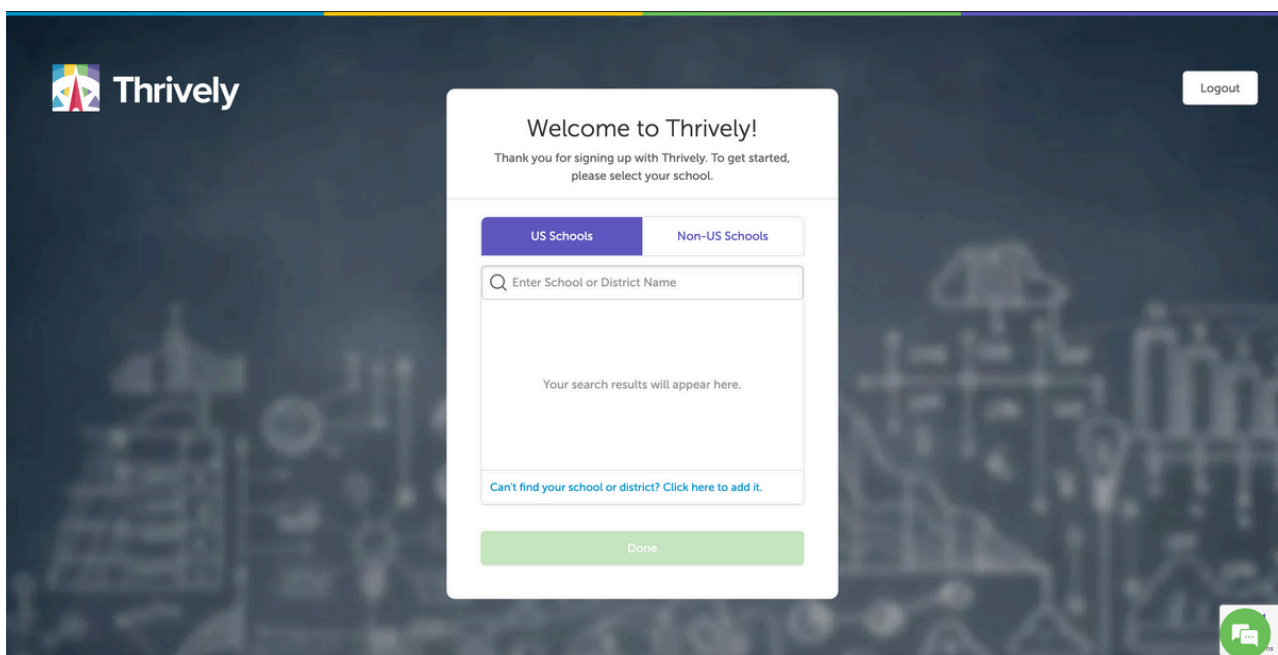
Step 1 — Whoever will be your school's/district's **main account administrator** will go to www.thrively.com and select “Join for Free” in the upper right corner.

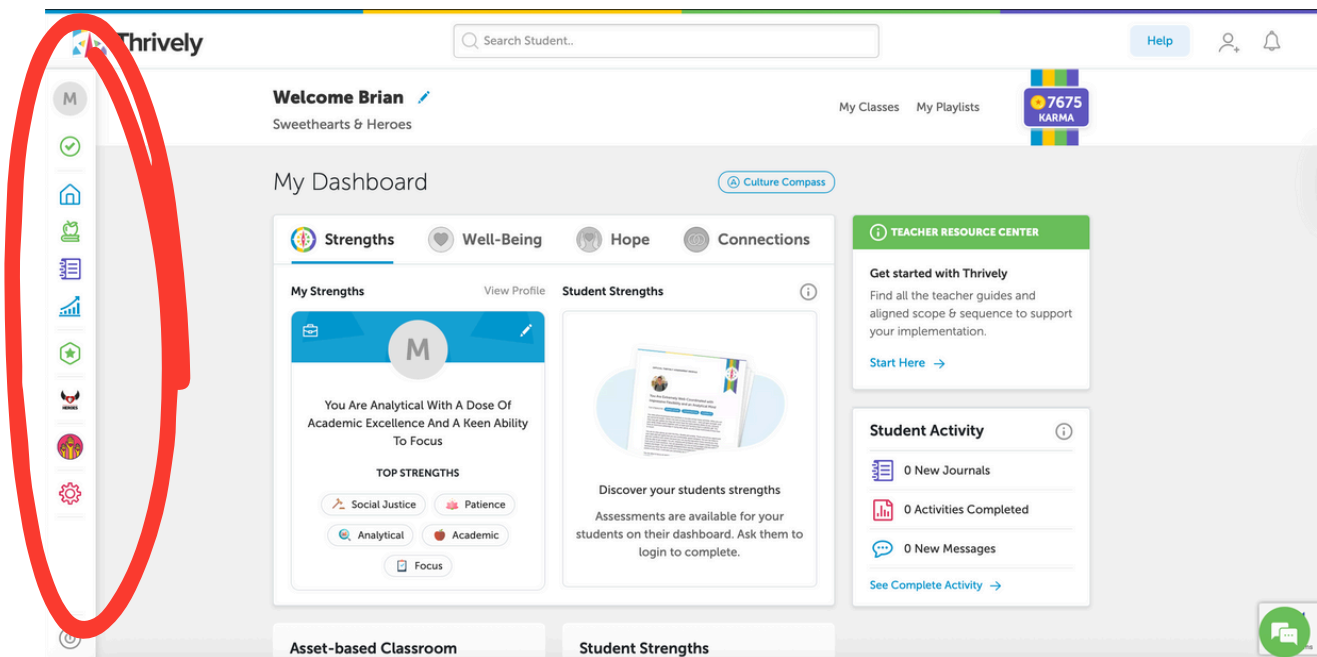
You can access all our materials under your “My Playlists” or the Sweethearts & Heroes icon located on the left side-bar on the platform.

DO NOT purchase any of our courses or playlists individually if you’ve already purchased the HOPE Classroom through us and our in-person services.

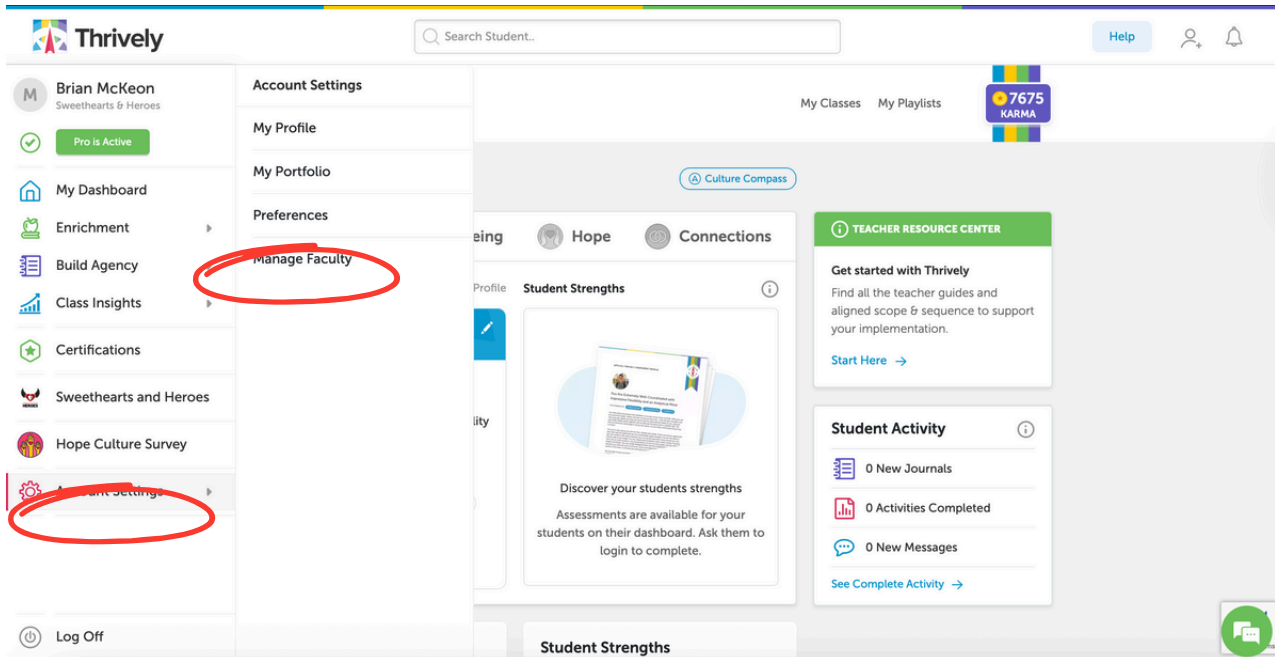
Step 5 — Add your teachers and students.

- 2** You can add through ClassLink or Clever by adding the “**ThrivelyApp**” to your dashboard

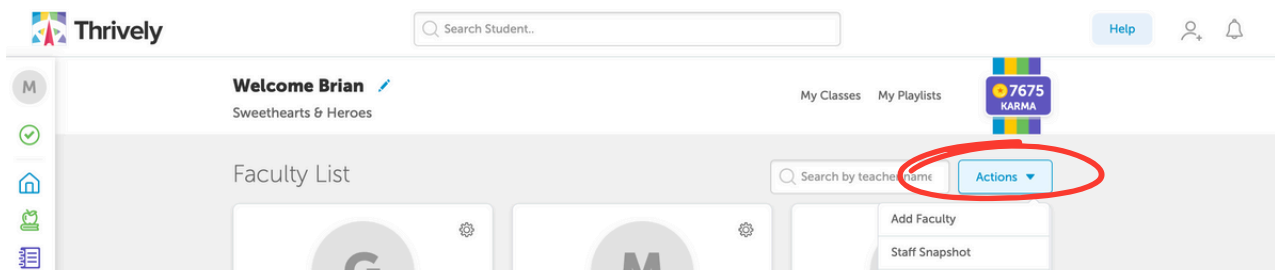
This is your home dashboard.



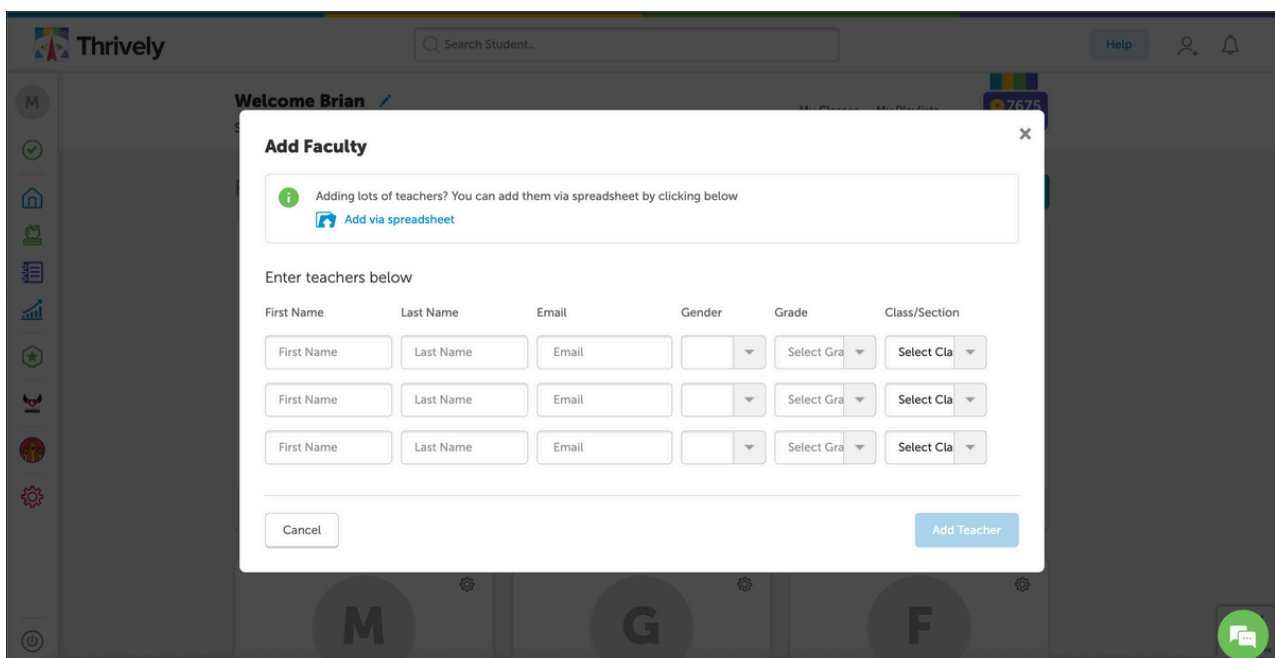
To manually add teachers, open the side-bar on the left, go to “Account Settings” and select “Manage Faculty.”



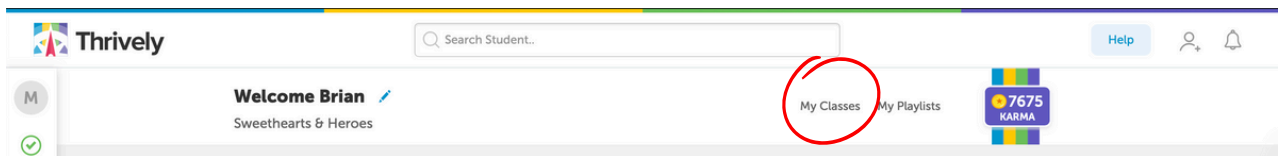
Select “Actions” then select “Add Faculty.”



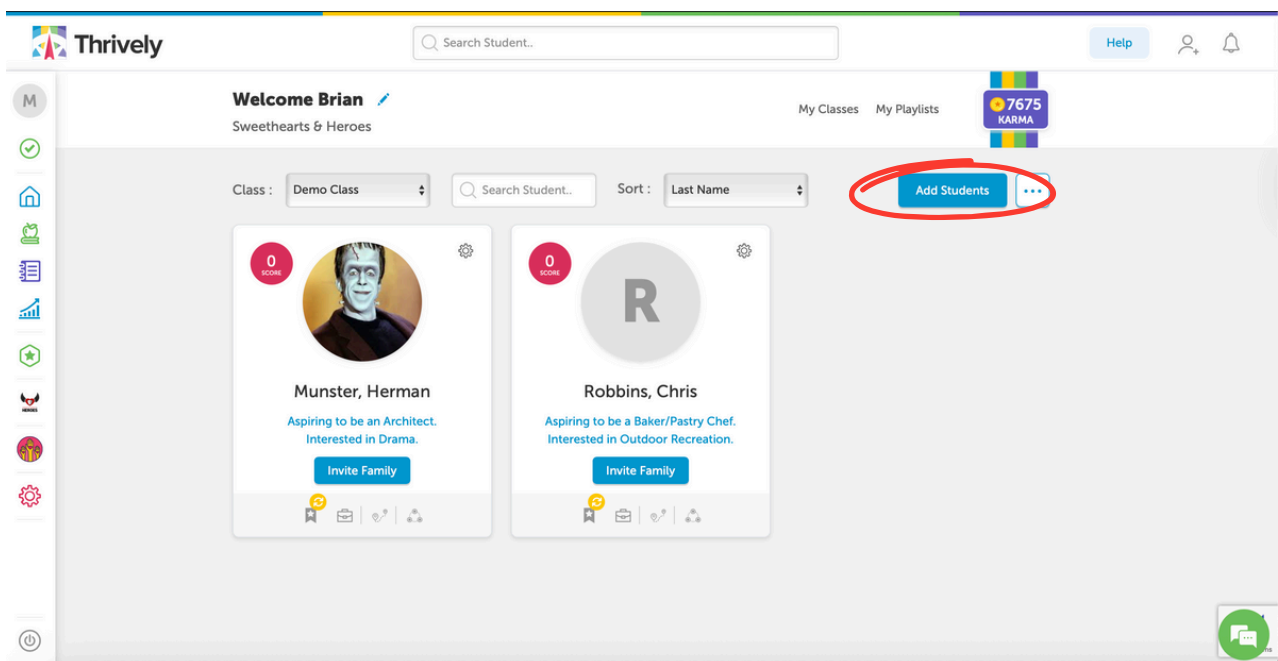
You can add individually or bulk upload a spreadsheet.



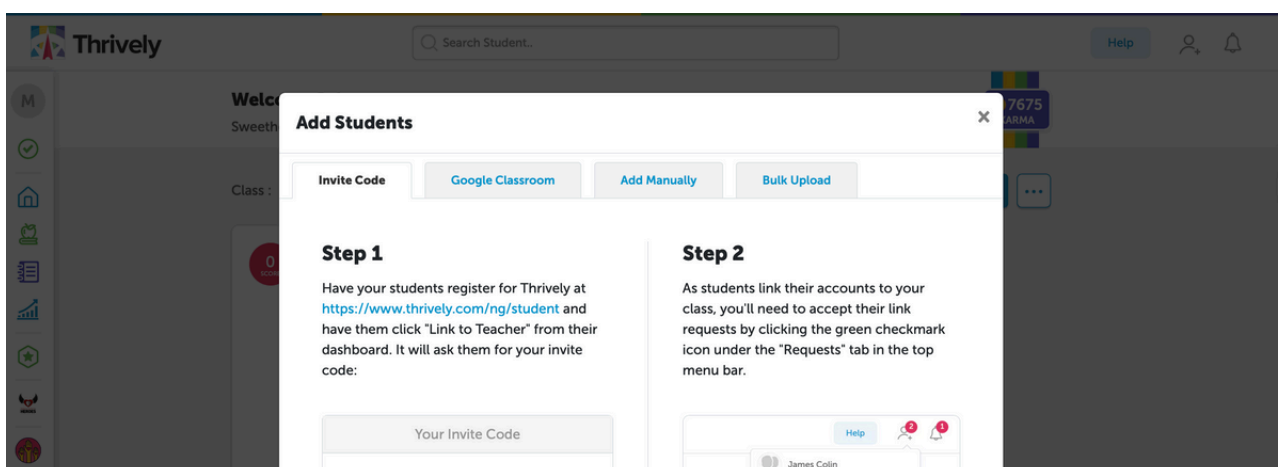
To manually add students, go to “My Classes” at the top navigation bar.



Select the “Add Students” button.

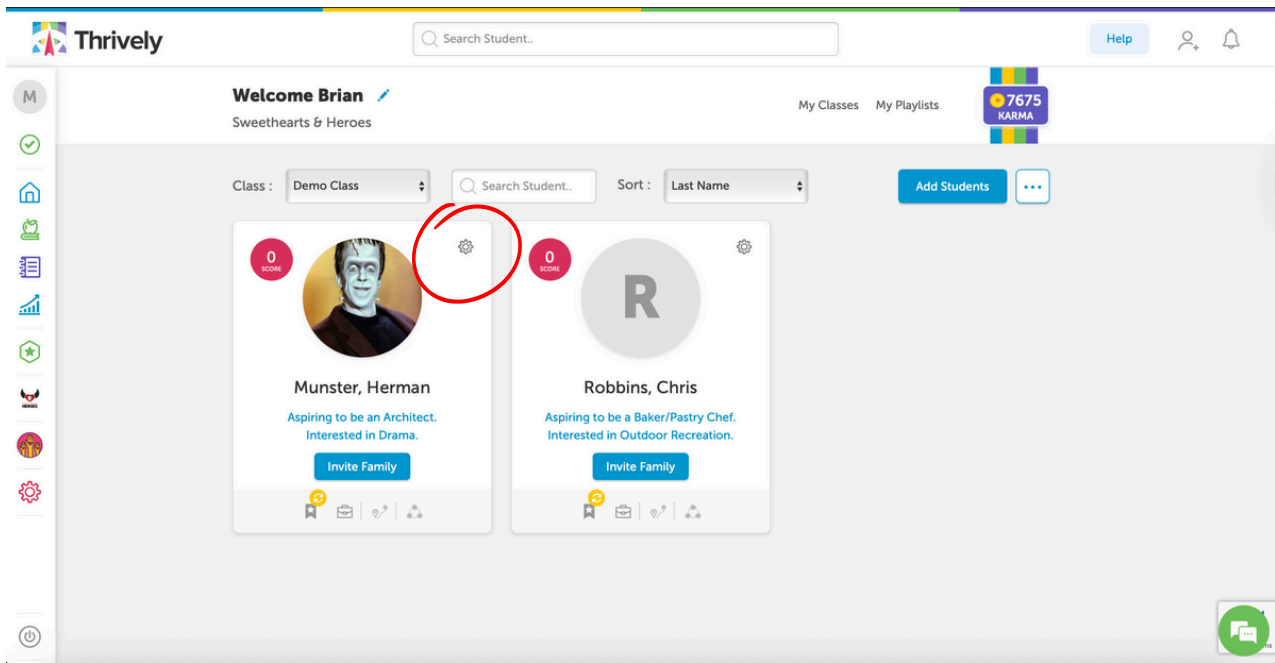


Then you'll have four (4) different options:

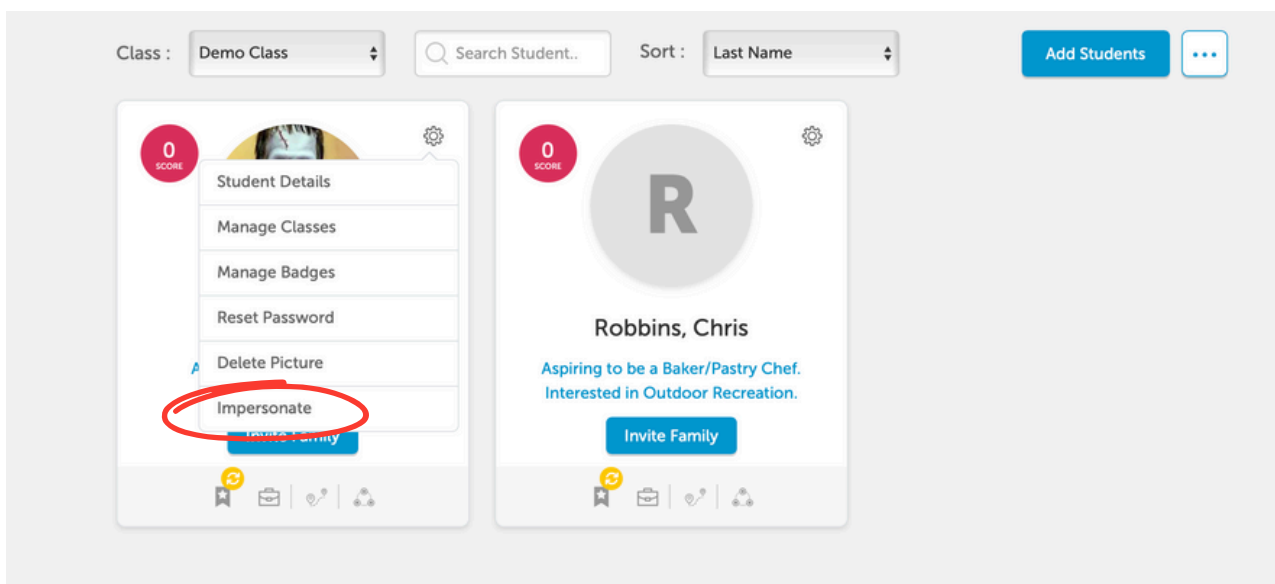


Once you've added your teachers and students, you and your team can assign playlists, courses, lessons, and projects to your students as you'd like.
